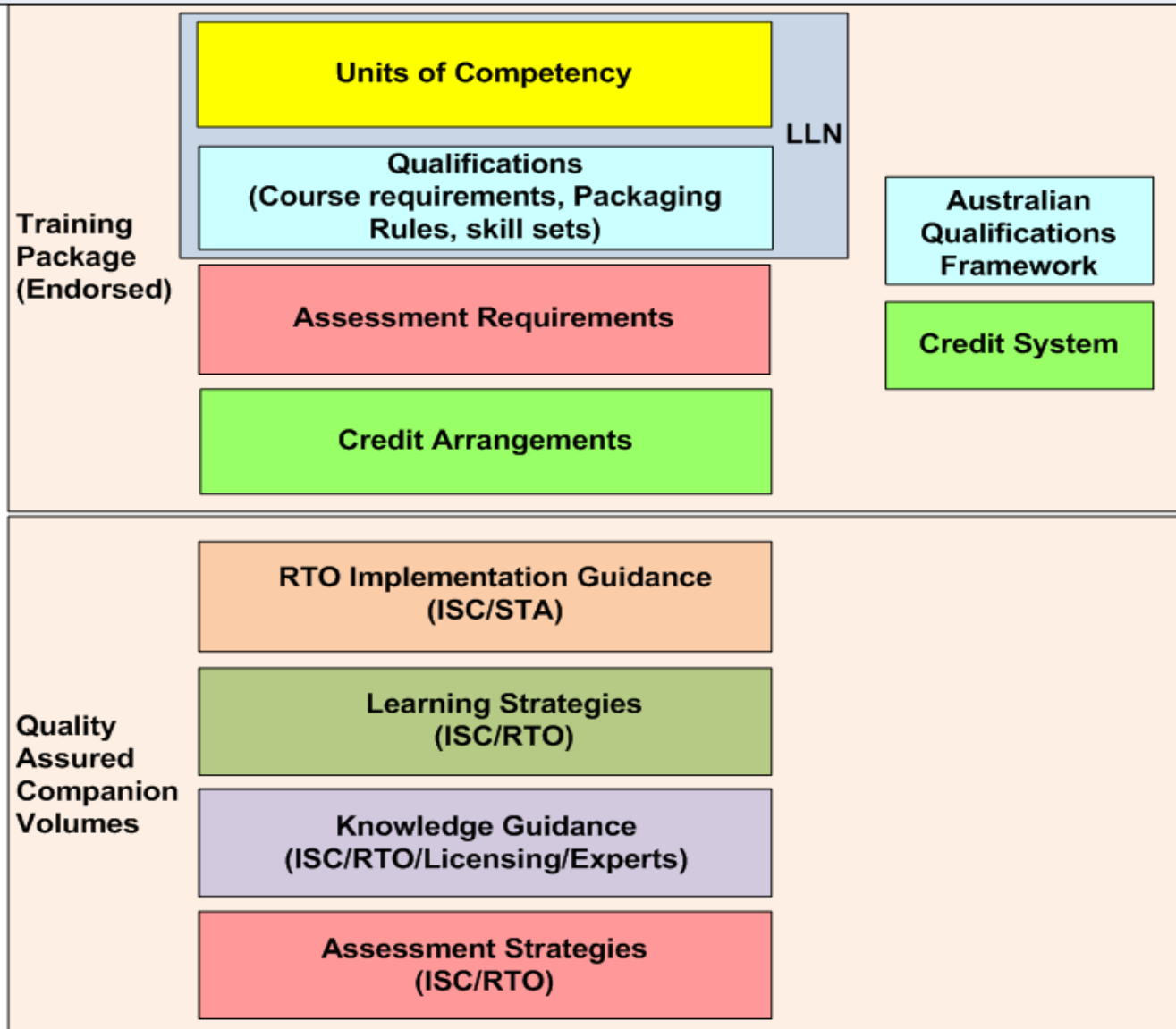

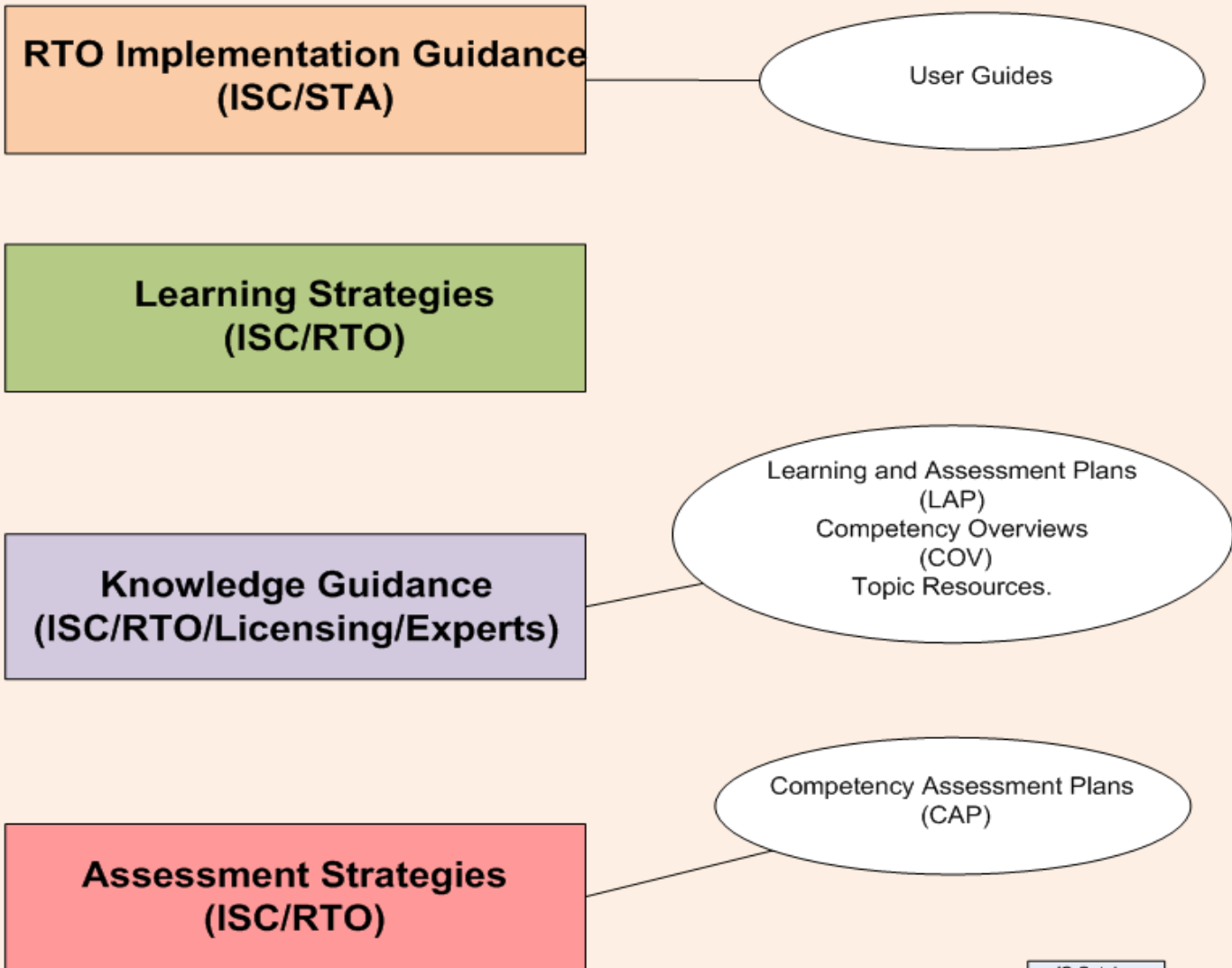

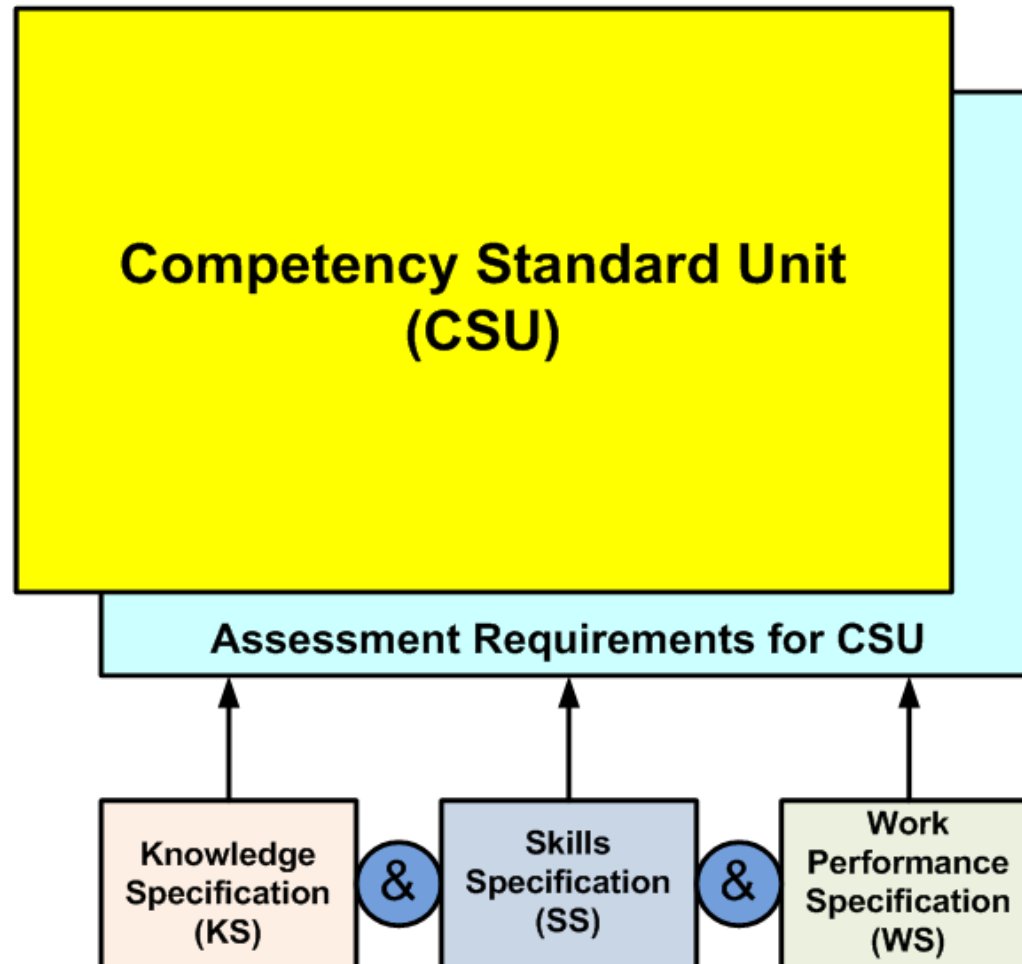

 - i.e. one EKAS clause per unit in most cases
- Recoding of EKAS numbering system
 - i.e. KS01-EE101A
- Using prerequisite units where necessary
- Relevant imported units i.e. high risk licensing units
